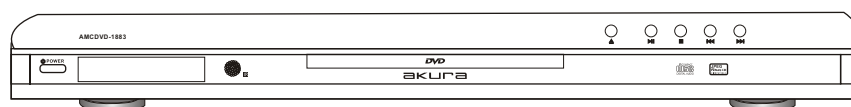



The MPEG II video compression technology provides capacity for an excellent picture of minimum 500 lines resolution on screen, up to 8 language soundtracks, up to 9 views from different camera angles and up to 32 language subtitles (provided by the DVD disc itself which supports these features).

Care of disc

Video disc contains high-density compressed data that needs proper handling

- Hold the disc with fingers. Hold the disc's outer edge and/or the center spindle hole. Do not touch the disc surface.



- Do not bend or press the disc. Do NOT expose the disc to direct sunlight or heating sources.

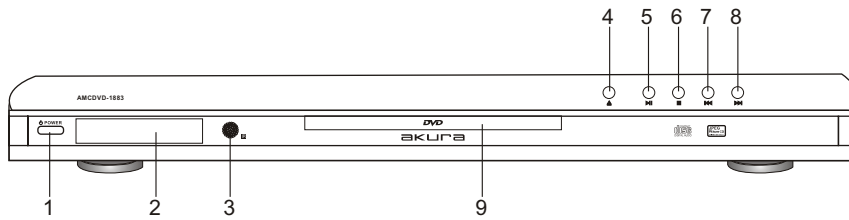


- Store discs in cabinet vertically, in dry condition. Prevent exposure to:
 - Direct sunlight
 - Heat or exhaust from a heating device.
 - Extreme humidity.
- Clean the disc surface with a soft, dry cleaning cloth. Wipe the disc surface gently, radially, from center toward the outer edge.
- Do not apply thinner, alcohol chemical solvent, or sprays when cleaning. Such cleaning fluids will permanently damage the disc surface.

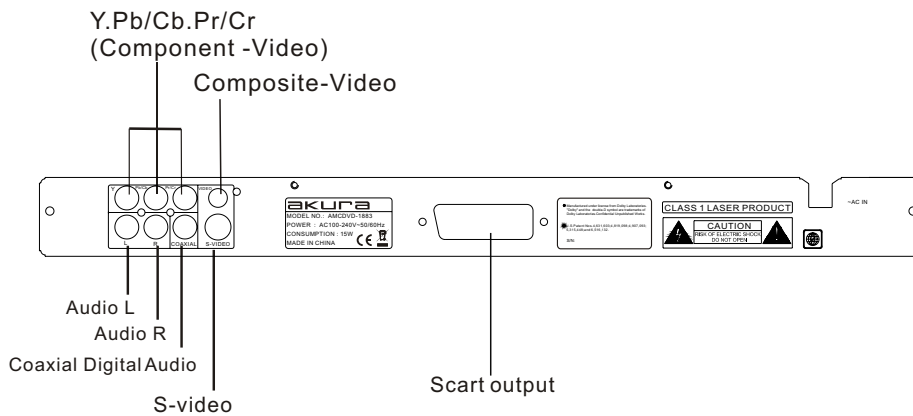

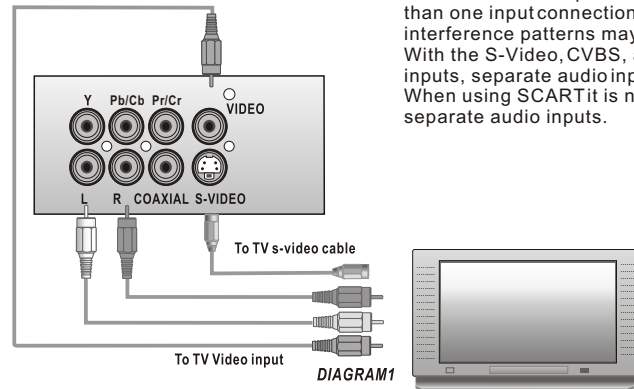

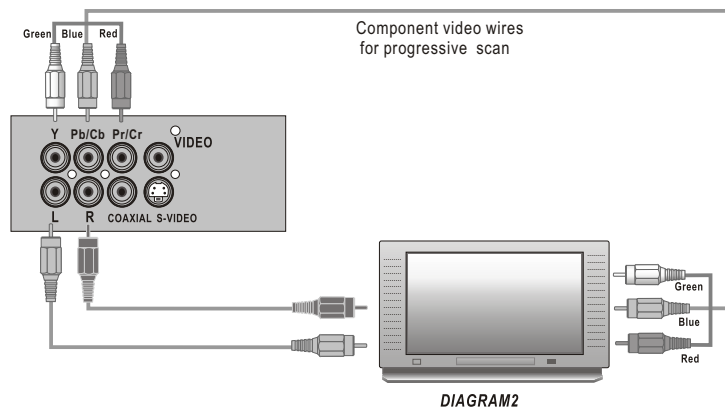


SYSTEM CONNECTION

System connection to a TV set



Select one video input method **ONLY**. If more than one input connection is made then interference patterns may be seen. With the S-Video, CVBS, and Progressive scan inputs, separate audio inputs must be used. When using SCART it is not necessary to connect separate audio inputs.

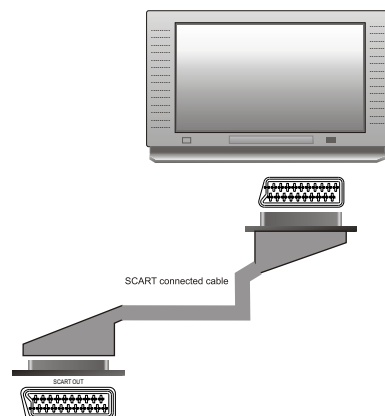


The player is equipped with 4 forms of output.

To view the DVD player, using Scart Output, most modern Tv's will select the DVD player automatically when the DVD player is switched On.

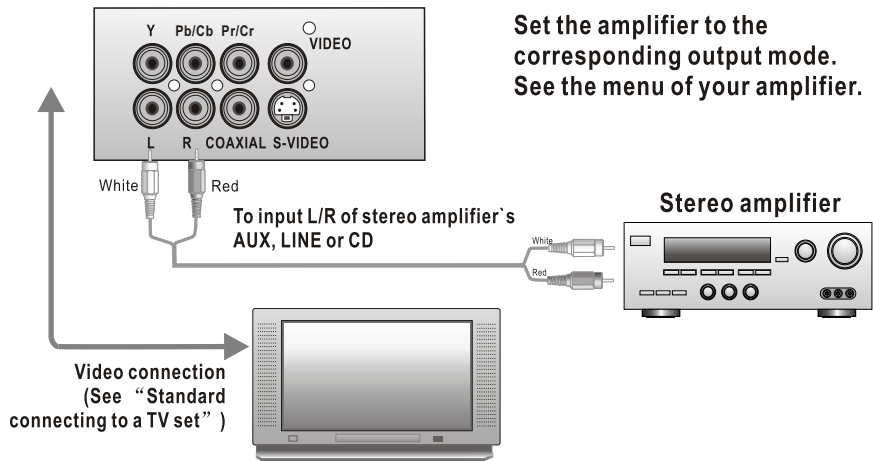
If using S-Video, Composite Video or Progressive Output, you will need to select the correct input using the Tv remote control.

If using an older Tv and Scart you may need to select AV on your Tv.

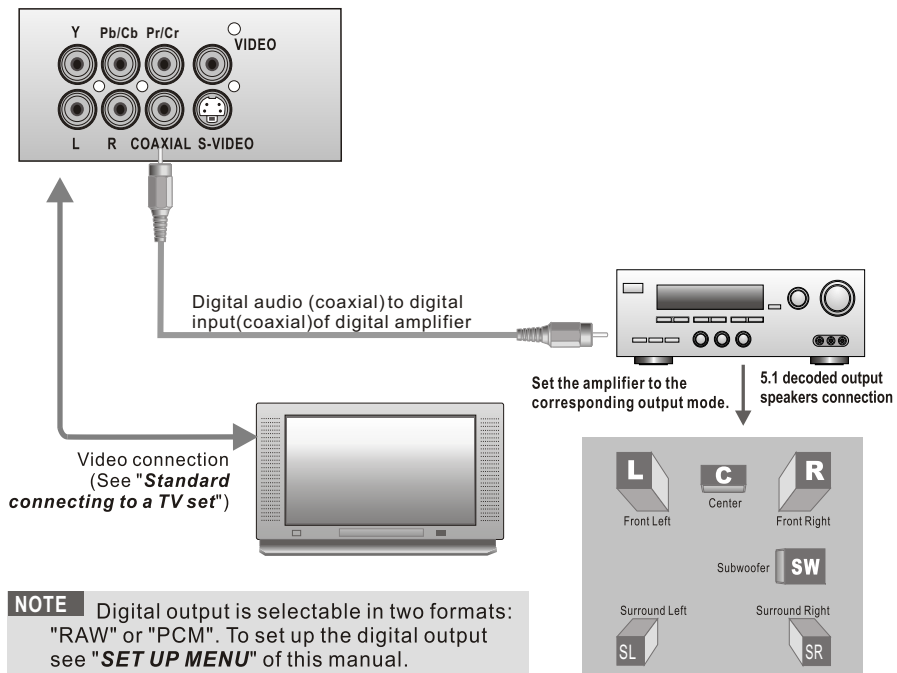


SYSTEM CONNECTION

Digital audio connection to a digital Amplifier

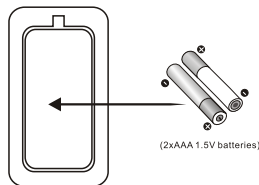


GETTING STARTED

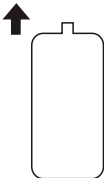
- Unpack the unit.
- Read through this owner's manual before installation and use.
- Load batteries into the remote control unit.
- Connect the system, make sure the connections are secured.
- Connect the power plug to the AC power outlet.

Loading batteries to the remote control

- Remove the battery compartment cover.
- Load two AAA (UM-4 or R03) batteries into the battery compartment.
- Make sure that the batteries have been inserted in the correct polarities matching to the symbols +, - marked in the battery compartment. Close the battery compartment cover.
- When replacing batteries, replace both batteries. Do not mix new and used batteries operating together, otherwise, the operation lifetime will be much shorter than normal.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be used for a prolonged period of time.



(2xAAA 1.5V batteries)



When batteries are replaced, do not break open exhausted batteries or throw on a fire, they may explode

The remote control transmits a directional infrared beam. Be sure to aim the remote control directly at the infrared sensor of the unit during operation.

If the sensor has been covered or there is a large object between the remote control and the sensor, the sensor will not respond.

The sensor may not be able to receive the remote signal when it is exposed to direct sunlight or a strong artificial light (fluorescent or strobe light). In this case, change the direction of the light or reposition the unit to avoid direct lighting.

Switch on the player

Press the main power switch on the DVD player. Power on the TV set, and the amplifier if connected.

Set up the system

Select the corresponding setting of the TV set (AV1, AV2, S-Video, DVD etc.).

For connection through a RF modulator, select the corresponding channel until the DVD screen appears.

If amplifier has been connected, select the corresponding output mode.

Load a disc

Press OPEN/CLOSE button  on the remote control (or front panel) to eject the disc tray.

Load a disc, label side up, onto the disc tray and press OPEN/CLOSE button.

Automatic playback

The unit will take a few seconds to load the disc's initial data, display the disc type logo on the left upper corner on screen, and then start playing back automatically.

If a DVD disc menu appears on screen



Press PLAY button on the remote (or on the unit) to start playing.

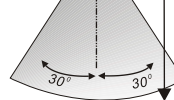


Press the DIRECTION buttons to select the desired feature in the menu. And then press ENTER button to confirm a selection in the menu.

GETTING STARTED

Problem disc messages

The following message will display on screen when there is a format problem with the loaded disc:

“WRONG REGIONAL DISC”

Region code of the disc is not matching to the player's region code (region 1 to region 6)
UK is region 2.

“WRONG PASSWORD”

The rating level of the disc is higher than the rating level setting of the player.
The player will not play the disc.

“WRONG DISC”

The player is equipped with automatic disc quality detection software. When the player detects a problem disc or a damaged disc, the player may keep playing the disc at lower quality or stop playing, depending on the damaged level of the disc.

Production qualities of DVD discs vary, some discs might deviate from the industrial standard. Some incorrectly formatted discs may playback on the player. However, the playback and operational quality of those disc may be substandard.

Power management

If not using the Player for long periods it is wise to turn off the power fully at the socket.

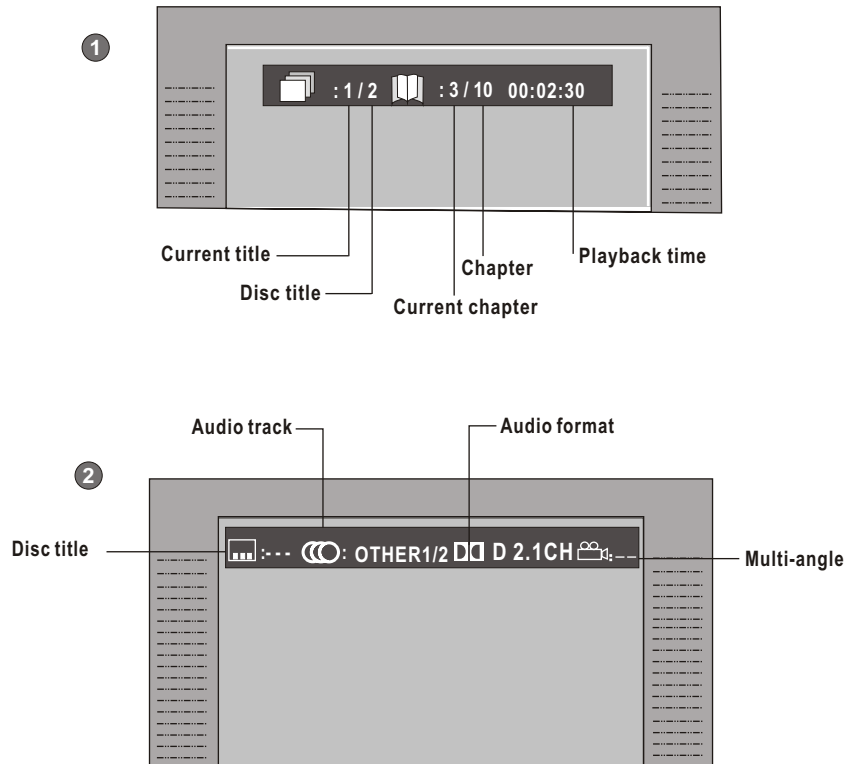
ON SCREEN DISPLAY

An On Screen Display (OSD) indicator will be displayed at the upper part of the TV screen when certain functions are executed, or when pressing the DISPLAY button on the remote control.

The OSD indicator is a user friendly interface designed to display the status of playback type. When a different disc is loaded (DVD, CD) ; the OSD indicator bar will be different.

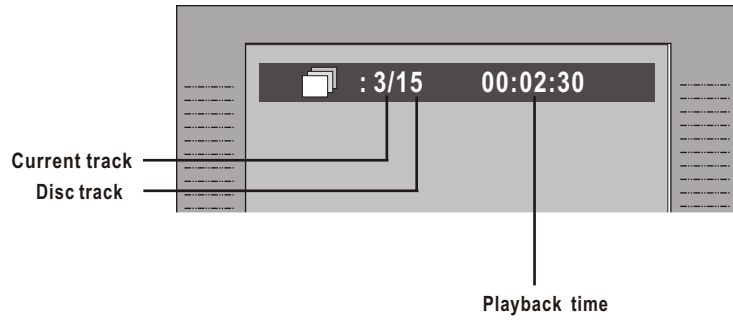
The OSD bar will appear automatically if it is activated by pressing the DISPLAY button. Press the DISPLAY button again and a new status bar will appear. Press DISPLAY button a third time and the OSD bar will disappear. When OSD indicator bar appears, press other button, the OSD indicator bar will disappear automatically.

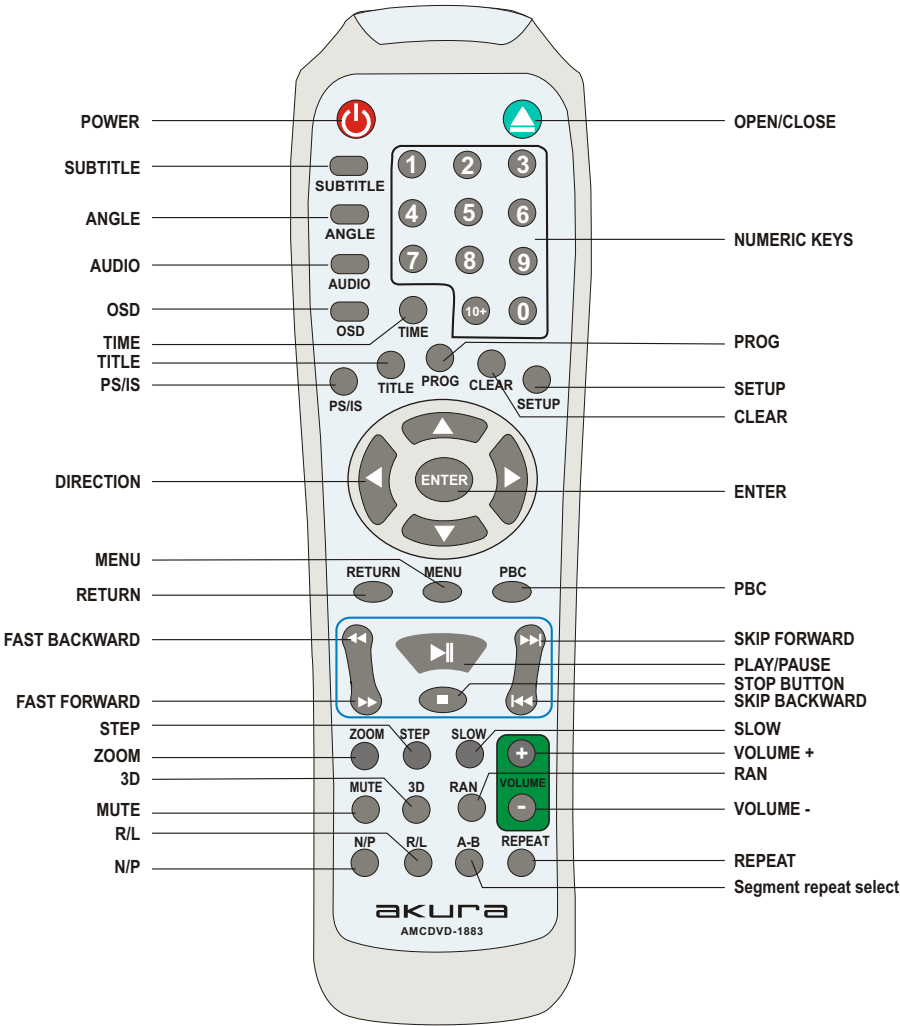

 A) Press the STOP button Once. STOP memorizes the interrupted position and the OSD shows "PRESTOP."
 B) Press the STOP button twice to completely stop the disc. The OSD shows STOP. When the PLAY button is pressed the disc will start from the beginning.


Slow
 The player is muted in SLOW mode.
 Press SLOW button to play at slow motion. Repeatedly pressing the button will decrease the slow speed.


Normal → X1/2 → X1/4 → X1/8 → X1/16 → X1/32

Skip Forward / Backward
 Press  button skip forward DVD chapter or CD track.
 Press  button skip backward DVD chapter or CD track.

NOTE
 Player will not skip forward or backward during "WARNING" section of a DVD disc.
 Single chapter DVD or single track CD cannot skip.

Fast backward/forward

Press  button to fast backward through the disc. Repeatedly pressing the button will increase the search speed.
 Normal → X2 → X4 → X8 → X16 → X32


Press  button to fast forward through the disc. Repeatedly pressing the button;
 Normal → X2 → X4 → X8 → X16 → X32

 Press PLAY button to resume normal playback.

NOTE

The player is muted in fast forward or fast backward this mode.
 Player will not fast forward or fast backward during WARNING section of a DVD disc.

DISC TITLE / MENU

MENU
 While playing a DVD.
 Press the MENU button return to the DVD disc start menu.

 Press PLAY button to resume play from where you previously stopped it.

TITLE
 While playing a DVD, press the TITLE button return to the beginning of the DVD disc.

NOTE

Some DVD discs refuse the TITLE function.

RETURN
 Press RETURN button returning to the upper level menu.

NOTE

The "Return" function is only effective when playing the disc of VCD2.0 in PBC ON mode.

FUNCTION BUTTON

Select an item in menu

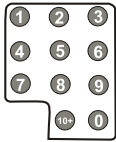

Numeric Key Pad

(Random Program access)



- 1) To direct access a DVD Chapter or a CD track, input the desired DVD Chapter or CD Track number using the numeric key pad.
- 2) Input data for the DVD disc start menu or the player's setup menu.

NOTE Some DVD discs do not allow direct access function.



Press **MUTE** button to select mute on or mute off.

Search a desired section

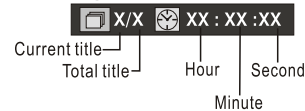
To search for a desired Title, Chapter, Time or Track.



In DVD mode pressing the **Go To** button once appear



pressing the **TIME** button twice appear



Press **ENTER** button to execute the search.

NOTE

Some DVD discs do not allow Search function. Search does not function during program play.

Repeat section A-B

To repeat playback a specific section of a disc.



Press the **A-B** button at the starting point of the desired section. "A" display on screen.



Press the **A-B** button again, at the end of the desired section, "A-B" display on screen. The play will start repeat playback the desired section A to B until the function is cancelled.



To cancel the function. Press the **A-B** button again return to normal play.

NOTE

Some DVD discs do not allow A-B function.

Repeat

Repeatedly playback desired Title, Chapter or Track.



Press **REPEAT** button repeatedly to select the repeat mode .

Multi - Angle / Subtitle / Audio

- ANGLE** While playing back a DVD disc, press the ANGLE button repeatedly to select the desired camera angle. A DVD disc may contain up to 9 selectable camera angles.
- SUBTITLE** While playing back a DVD disc, press the SUBTITLE button repeatedly to select the desired SUBTITLE. A DVD disc may contain up to 32 selectable subtitles.
- AUDIO** While playing back a DVD disc, press the AUDIO button repeatedly to select the desired audio sound track. A DVD disc may contain up to 8 selectable audio sound tracks.

NOTE
DVD disc start menu may contain set up of Angle, Subtitle and Audio soundtrack selection. You may do the selection in the disc start menu.

Volume Up / Down

- While playing back a disc. Press the VOLUME button- or + to adjust the volume output. Volume level will display on screen.



The volume level control does not apply to digital output levels when a DVD disc is playing.

ZOOM

- PLAY DVD**
Press the ZOOM button repeatedly TV Screen display:
ZOOM X2--> ZOOMX 4--> ZOOM OFF
- PLAY JPEG**
Press the ZOOM button repeatedly TV Screen display scale:
150%-->200%-->25%-->50%-->100%
While zoom 100%, press direction button to rotate picture.
While zoom 150%.200%,press direction button to move picture position.

NOTE
The picture quality is degraded as the picture size increased.

SETUP

- SETUP** Press the SETUP button to enter the player's setup menu. Setup menu is a facility for the owner to adjust the detail setting of the player. For the detail of Setup menu see "SET UP MENU" of this instruction manual.

PROGRAM

To program play a disc in a desired sequence.

- PROGRAM** In PBC off mode, Press PROGRAM button, to enter the program menu.



In DVD mode

When the program menu appears input the Title number, press ENTER. Then input title Chapter number, press ENTER button.



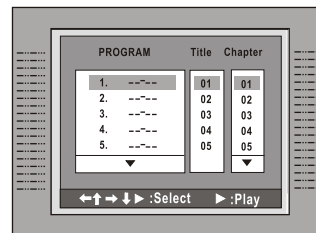
(PLAY) --- Press PLAY button to start program play.



(CLEAR) --- Press CLEAR button if you want to cancel the wrong information you input. Press CLEAR again to cancel all the tracks.



(PROG) --- Press PROG button to quit the program menu.



In CD mode

When the program menu appears, input the Track number, press ENTER, when the programming is completed.



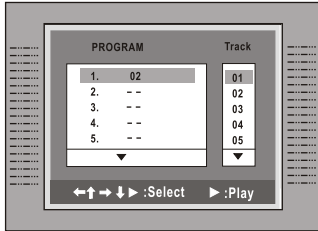
(PLAY) --- Press PLAY button to start program play.



(STOP) --- Press twice STOP button to quit the program mode.

NOTE

1. Certain DVD disc are formatted in wide screen (16:9) or letter box (4:3) only. Adjusting the setting of the disc player will not alter the screen size for these "Format-only" discs.
2. The PSCAN button on the remote should only be used if you have a Component Video Connection
3. If you TV does not have a Y, Cb, Cr Component function, please do not change Video Out setting

CUSTOM SETUP

After entering the main menu, choose and confirm "CUSTOM setup" and then the following window will appear on the TV screen.



A) "Parental Control"

There are 8 levels of Parental Control, as follows:
1: KID SAF; 2: G; 3: PG; 4: PG 13; 5: PGR; 6: R; 7: NC 17;
8: ADULT Level one opens discs to people of all ages.
Level eight is suitable only for adults.

If you want to change the Parental Control setting, enter the level number and then the four digit pass code. The default code is 8888. (If you are using the player for the first time, there is the code that is needed.)

When the input code has been confirmed, the level setting menu will appear. Move the cursor to the appropriate level and press ENTER to confirm. Press Set Up to exit the Menu.

B) "Password"

Move the cursor to the PASSWORD prompt and press ENTER. Input the password 8888 if this is your first use.

After confirmation, you will be required to input a new 4 digit pass code. After entering your new pass code, press ENTER to confirm.

WARNING: Please keep a copy of the new pass code in a safe place. Otherwise you will not be able to change the Parental Control. Please remember your PASSWORD, as the DEFAULT setting will revert everything BUT the PASSWORD to the factory defaults.

C) "ANGLE MARK" You can choose to have the ANGLE MARK function ON or OFF. In the ON mode, an ICON will display on the screen when a disc has multiple angle shots available for viewing. Press ANGLE on the remote to enjoy these scenes.

D) "DEFAULT" This function allows you to change the player back to the factory default settings. All settings will be changed back to the original settings. If you have changed the default PASSWORD of 8888, this will not revert.
