

#### Mains Power


Your 60W Soundbar requires a mains supply of 230-240V AC ~ 50Hz. Please ensure that your mains supply is compatible before use. Disconnect the Power Cord from the mains when not in use.

#### Position of 60W Soundbar

Place on a flat, stable surface that is not subject to vibrations. Avoid the following locations:

- Where it is exposed to direct sunlight
- Where it is close to heat radiating sources
- Where the humidity is high and ventilation is poor
- Where it is dusty

- Remote Control
- Wall Mount Kit



#### A (<sup>1</sup>) POWER

Press to power the soundbar on or off.



Press to select input. **O** + VOLUME

Press to increase the volume.

**D** – VOLUME

Press decrease the volume.



#### B BLUETOOTH

Press to pair the Bluetooth device with soundbar after access to BT mode.

#### ILINE IN SOCKET

Connect external audio source with 3.5mm audio cable.

#### AUX INPUT SOCKET


Connect external audio sources with RCA audio cable.

Connect external audio sources with optical cable.


#### C MAIN INPUT SOCKET


Connect external mains adaptor to this socket.




# 3 Quick Setup



#### 3.1 Power On/Off and Function Selection

- 1. This 60W Soundbar is supplied with a mains adaptor. To connect the power, insert the small end in the rear of the unit(DC20V).
- 2. Insert the UK plug into a household power socket, and switch the power on.
- 3. Press the  $, \mathbf{b}$  button to turn the unit on.
- 4. Press the 🕞 button to select Bluetooth/Line in/Aux/Optical mole.



#### 3.2 Auto Power Off

If no audio signal is continuously detected from the selectal mode in for more than 170 minutes, the unit will power-off automatically.

#### 3.3 Adjusting the Volume

Press the + button or - button on the side of the soundbar to adjust the volume to a comfortable level.



# 4 Operation



#### 4.1 Selecting LINE IN

- 1. Press the <sup>()</sup> button in the side of the soundbar or alternatively press the STANDBY button on the remote control, so that the blue LED is illuminated.
- 2. Press the G button and select LINE IN mode or press the LINE IN button on your remote control.
- 3. Adjust volume to the desired level.

#### 4.2 Selecting AUX IN

- 2. Press the G button and select AUX IN mode or press the AUX button on your remote control.
- 3. Adjust volume to the desired level.

#### 4.3 Selecting Optical in

- 1. Connect one end of Optical cable to the back of the soundbar and the other end to the OPTICAL OUTPUT of your TV.
- 2. Press the <sup>()</sup> button in the side of the soundbar or alternatively press the STANDBY button on the remote control, so that the blue LED is illuminated.
- 3. Press the appropriate OPTICAL button on your remote control to select the input.
- 4. Adjust volume to the desired level.

#### 4.4 Selecting Bluetooth

- 1. Press and hold the 🖒 button on the unit or alternatively press the STANDBY button on the Remote Control.
- 2. Press the G button and select Bluetooth mode or press the BT button on the Remote Control to switch Bluetooth mode.
- 3. Press the 🚯 button on the unit. The blue light will flash quickly.
- 4. Use the controls on your Bluetooth device to select (GDSB04BT60) in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password, enter the "0000". Refer to your device's user manual for instuctions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.



Problem	What to do
Soundbar does not respond (no power).	Check the mains power cable and make sure it is plugged into a suitable power outlet.
	Check that the mains power supply is switched on.
	Connect the power to a different power outlet.
No sound.	Check the Soundbar volume control is not at minimum.
	Check that the Soundbar is not set to MUTE.
	If you are connecting to the Soundbar using a headphones port on your external audio device then check the volume is turned up on that device.
The Remote Control does not work.	Replace the battery.
	Make sure there are no obstacles obscuring the Soundbar.
No sound in Bluetooth mode.	Check that the Soundbar is Paired with a Bluetooth device. If prompted enter the code '0000'.
