



# Important information regarding the digital TV switchover

Television in the UK is going digital, bringing us all more choice and new services. Starting late 2007 and ending in 2012, television services in the UK will go completely digital, TV region by TV region.

# How the switchover affects your TV equipment.

Your new TV has a digital tuner built in, which means it is ready to receive the Freeview signal by simply connecting it into your aerial socket (you can check if you can get digital TV through your aerial now or whether you will have to wait until the switchover at <a href="https://www.digitaluk.co.uk">www.digitaluk.co.uk</a>)

When the TV switchover happens in your area, there are at least two occasions when you will need to re-tune your TV in order to continue receiving your existing TV channels and also to pick up new ones. Digital UK, the body leading the digital switchover, will advise you when you need to retune during the switchover.

#### How to retune.

Retuning your TV is a very quick and simple process. We recommend that you retune every few months to ensure you are receiving the very latest TV and radio channels that are broadcast.

- In digital/freeview mode, on the remote control press 'menu' quickly followed by 8-8-8 (so press the number 8 four times)
- You will now enter the 'First time installation' mode. (if you do not, please refer to the section called 'getting started' later in this user guide)



• Simply press 'OK' or 'Enter' on the remote control and follow the on-screen instructions.

If you do not retune your TV when advised to do so by Digital UK, you may lose some or all of your channels until you do re-tune.

If you are missing any channels, it may be that they are not available in your area, or that your TV aerial needs upgrading.

# **Warnings**



#### Screen Burn

A characteristic of LCD TV Panels is that displaying the same image for along time may cause apermanent after - image to remain on the screen. This is called screen burn. Most pictures shown on your TV will be constantly moving and fill the screen.

Examples of images that you need to watch out for are as follows (this is not an all-inclusive list):

- TV Channel Logos: e.g. Shopping channel logos and pricing displays-especially if they are bright and stationary. Moving or low-contrast graphics are less likely to cause ageing of the screen.
- Picture-in-Picture and Multi Picture-in-Picture: Do not view for long periods of time using the Picture-in-Picture or Multi Picture-in-Picture functions.
- Time Displays
- Teletext: Do not view a stationary page for long periods of time.
- TV/DVD Menus: e.g. Listings of DVD disk content.
- Pause Mode: Do not leave the TV in pause mode for long periods of time, e.g. When watching DVDs or videos.

Note: To prevent screen burn if viewing any of the above for long periods of time, reduce contrast and brightness when viewing. Once burn-in occurs it will never disappear completely.







# **Getting Started - Initial Set Up**

# IMPORTANT - AFTER TUNING DO NOT PRESS ANY BUTTONS FOR 20 SECONDS SO THE CHANNEL INFORMATION CAN BE STORED.

#### **TUNING IN TV**

IMPORTANT — Please ensure the TV has reached room temperature before connecting the power for the first time

- 1a) Connect the mains lead to your electrical outlet and switch on the TV using the switch next to where the power cable goes into the TV
- 1b) 15" Model Connect the power cable from the wall to transformer and from transformer to the power input on the TV.

2) Connect the RF Cable supplied to the RF.IN' on the rear of the TV and connect the other end of the cable to your TV Aerial outlet



3) Install batteries in the remote control and press the [POWER] button to turn on the TV.



The 'Initial Set up' menu should now appear if it does not press [MENU] 8-8-8-8.

4) Press [OK] on the remote control.



5) Select the required language then press [OK]

6) Select country then press [OK]




7) Press [OK] and tuning will take place.



8) After tuning a screen will appear to confirm tuning is complete. Press [OK] and you can now watch TV.

**Important** - Due to signal strength variations across the UK for Digital TV, please note that not all of the channels/services may be available in your region. Over the coming months as coverage increases, more services and channels may become available. In the event of poor reception in either Analogue TV or Digital TV (DVB) it may be necessary to install a signal 'booster' to enhance reception. For Digital/Freeview TV (DVB) you may need to upgrade your aerial to a High Gain Digital version.

# **Remote Control Buttons**



# **Connecting HD Ready Devices**

There are two options for HD.

- 1) By connecting via HDMI cable (not included) this provides both HD picture and sound.
- 2) By connecting via Component (YPbPr) cable (not included) this provides HD picture. Source should be set to YPbPr.

To receive sound you will need to connect your left and right audio to the YPbPr/S-Video Audio, using the cable included.













Lets you change the picture mode presets between User -> Cinema -> Sport -> Vivid -> Hi-Bright -> Standard

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [>] to enter Video Menu
- 3) Picture Mode should be highlighted
- 4) Press [>] to change between the different options



5) Press [EXIT] to exit

# **Adjusting Brightness**

Increase or decrease the brightness of the picture

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [>] to enter Video Menu
- 3) Press [V] to highlight Brightness
- 4) Press [>] to increase the brightness or [<] to decrease the brightness.



















# **Adjusting Contrast**

Adjust the balance between black & white and vivid.

- 3) Press [V] to highlight Contrast
- 4) Press [>] to make the picture more vivid or [<] to make the picture more black & white.



5) Press [EXIT] to exit

# **Adjusting Colour**

Increase or decrease the Red, Green & Blue which make up the picture.

# **Adjusting Sharpness**

Increase or decrease the sharpness of the picture. If you have a poor signal strength you should reduce the sharpness to get a better picture.

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [>] to enter Video Menu
- 3) Press [V] to highlight Sharpness
- 4) Press [>] to increase the sharpness or [<] to decrease the sharpness.



5) Press [EXIT] to exit

# **Dynamic Noise Reduction**

Reduces the interference in the picture. Medium -> Strong -> Auto -> Off -> Low

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [>] to enter Video Menu
- 3) Press [V] to highlight DNR
- 4) Press [>] to switch between the different options.

















# **Adjusting Colour Balance**

Select between the different present colour balance options or adjust manually. User -> Cool -> Standard -> Warm

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [>] to enter Video Menu
- 3) Press [V] to highlight Colour Balance



4) Press [>] to enter menu



- 5) Press [>] to switch between the different presets or move down and adjust the red, green and blue manually.
- 6) Press [EXIT] to exit

- 5) Press [>] to increase the bass and [<] to decrease the bass

















# **Adjusting Treble**

To increase or decrease the high frequency part of the sound.

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [V] to highlight Audio Menu
- 3) Press [>] to enter Audio Menu
- 4) Press [V] to highlight Treble
- 5) Press [>] to increase the treble and [<] to decrease the treble



6) Press [EXIT] to exit

# **Surround Sound**

This provides virtual surround sound so the sound appears to be coming from around you.

- 1) Press [MENU] to enter menu
- 2) Press [V] to highlight Audio Menu
- 3) Press [>] to enter Audio Menu

- 5) Enter the password, you can then block channels, inputs, programs as well as setting a new password.

The Electronic Program Guide (EPG) is available in Digital TV mode. It is a TV guide and provides information about forthcoming programmes (where supported by the broadcasted channel).

You can view the start and end time of all programs and on all channels.

It is very simple to operate.

1) Press [EPG]. The following will appear



2) Press [>] or [<] to select channel you wish to see information about



- 3) Press [V] or [/\] to move through the programs for the day highlighted
- 4) Press [EPG] to exit Electronic Program Guide (EPG).

With Digital TV (Freeview) there is also digital teletext available on some channels. Simply follow the on screen commands. Here is an example of the BBC digital teletext service.

1) To start digital teletext press RED button.



2) To select the information you require you can scroll using [\/] or [\/] and press [OK] alternatively you can key the page number for example [3][0][0] followed by [OK]



You can then navigate using the colour buttons (Red, Green, Yellow, Blue), the [\/] [/\] buttons and numbers.
