
9 SD card and USB device connections

See the diagram below. Note the orientation of the SD $\mbox{\sc Card}.$




Playing files stored on SD card & USB devices

The system will search the media for compatible files and by default will display a list of Movie files if these are present.




Press the GREEN button to list any music files found, the YELLOW button to list any photo files found, the BLUE button to list any games files found.

Press the OK button to play or display the file.



Connect the aerial to the RF connector on the connector strip on the rear of the TV. **75 OHM AERIAL** PLUG 5 TV CONNECTOR PANEL It is recommended that you use a rooftop aerial to carry out the First Time Install for both Analogue

and Digital TV channels.

Digital TV

Connect power

Your player can be powered from the mains supply via the adapter supplied and from an external 12V d.c. supply.

Connect the preferred power supply to the connector panel on the rear as shown below, either AC mains via the AC/DC Adapter or an external DC supply such as the output available from the cigar lighter in a car for example, or caravan.



Basic TV operation

Analogue TV. Press the INPUT button and then the ▲▼ buttons to highlight TV. Press the OK button.

Digital TV. Press the INPUT button and then the ▲▼ buttons to highlight DTV. Press the OK button

Changing channels. Press the CH+ or CH- buttons to step up/down the list of stored stations. The selected channel will be displayed. Stop when you reach the required station.

Alternatively enter the channel number on the numeric keys.

Volume. The volume is adjusted using the VOL + and - buttons. Press + to increase and - to decrease the volume.

Mute. To temporarily turn off the sound on your TV,

Press the MUTE button. The volume will be turned off and the mute symbol will be displayed on the screen.

To restore the sound when in the MUTE mode,

Press the MUTE button again or press the VOL + or - buttons.

The sound level will be restored and the mute symbol cleared.

First time installation - Analogue

Press the INPUT button to display the list of input sources.

Press the ▲▼ buttons to highlight TV and then press the OK button to set the input source.

Press the MENU button to display the main menu:



Use the ▲▼◀ ▶ buttons to select the TV Setup button as shown above and then press the OK button to display the first setup page:



Press the ▼ button to select the TV Settings icon (below left) and then press the ▼ button to select Auto Search.

Press the ▶ button to scan for analogue TV channels.

When scanning has finished, the first TV station stored will be displayed.

Playing a disc

Press the INPUT button and then the ▲▼ buttons to highlight DVD. Press the OK button

Load disc

Carefully push the disc into the slot until it engages with the dive mechanism and then release the disc.

The disc will then be automatically taken inside and the disk will start to play.

Pause, Play, Stop

Press the Play/Pause button (II) to pause play; press again to resume play.

Press the Stop button (to stop play.

Press Stop again when you want to remove the disc and then press the EJECT button to eject the disc. Carefully remove the



Press the INPUT button to display the list of input sources.

Press the ▲▼ buttons to highlight DTV and then press the OK button to set the input source.

The install message box will be displayed.



Use the ◀ ▶ buttons to select Yes and then press the OK button.

The 'Channel Search' window will be displayed and the unit will begin searching for TV and radio channels.



When the search has finished, the installation window will close and the first TV channel will be shown. Information about the channel will appear briefly along the bottom of the screen and the Quick Select window will be displayed.

Press the MENU button to clear this window.

Recording from digital TV

This player is equipped with Record Me functionality to let you record Digital TV to a USB device.

Press INPUT and use the ▲ ▼ buttons to select DTV Use CH+/- buttons to select the TV channel to record.

Connect the USB device to the player, see panel 9.

Press the MENU button to display the main menu.

Use the ▲▼◀ ▶ buttons to select REC.SETTINGS and then press the OK button.

The REC NOW button will already be selected.

Press the OK button to start to recording.

Press the REC button when you want to stop recording.

Select Yes in the message box displayed to stop recording and then press OK to confirm.
